



Frederick Porter Griffin, 93, Corydon, died Wednesday, Oct. 29, 2008, at Harrison Health and Rehabilitation Centre in Corydon.

Born April 7, 1915, he was the son of the late **Maurice and Charlotte Rupp Griffin**. He was the owner of Maurice Griffin and Co. Inc. Dry Goods store in Corydon, was a former teacher for Corydon and Paoli high schools, was a former employee of Winston Brothers Construction Co. in Charlestown, was a local historian and genealogist, was a graduate of Indiana University in Bloomington, served on the Corydon library board, the Corydon Central school corporation board, the Corydon State Bank board of directors, the Cedar Hill Cemetery board of regents, The Harrison County Sesquicentennial Committee, was president of the Harrison County Historical Society, was a member of the Corydon Presbyterian Church and Pisgah Lodge 32 F&AM in Corydon and operated a tree farm on the Ohio River in Southern Harrison County known as "Porter's Point."

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, **Eleanor Ashton Griffin**. Survivors include a son, **Patrick Ashton Griffin** of Corydon.

Perry County Funeral Notices

Submitted by **Doris B. Leistner**

Before daily newspapers and other communications, funeral notices were printed on paper and distributed around town as handbills. They were usually about 5 1/2 x 4 1/4 inches, sometimes with a black border, stating the name of the deceased, date of death, and sometimes age or birth date, parents, spouse, and other relatives; date and place of funeral and burial date and place. Residence was often noted.

A collection of about 700 funeral notices were found in the former Dusch Drugstore on Main St., Tell City and were given to Doris Leistner sometime in the 1970s. Those were some of the deaths in the 1890s and early 1900s in Tell City, Cannelton, and Troy in Perry Co., Indiana. After being arranged alphabetically, these were translated and transcribed by Mrs. Leistner. Some were printed in English or German, or both. Other sources researched to verify and add information were cemetery listings, church records, Perry Co. Death Records, and newspaper obituaries. The additional sources are listed in [].

The original records were photocopied and later donated to the Tell City Historical Society. The transcripts/abstracts will be published and available about June 2009. Contact the author, Doris Leistner, for more information about the coming book.
